Legal: Insurance cover in place that meets statutory requirements as a minimum

Health and Safety: A health and safety policy signed by MD or equivalent. Procedures in place for carrying out risk assessments, developing and implementing method statements, and a system for monitoring, auditing and reviewing procedures on an on-going basis. A commitment to appropriate welfare facility provision. Procedures for appointing competent sub-contractors and monitoring performance. Records kept of all RIDDOR reportable accidents for the last three years.

Environmental: An environmental policy statement signed by the MD or equivalent

Training: Registered with CITBCS (or exemption certificate provided). A company training plan which aims to ensure workers engaged have sufficient skills, appropriate qualifications and experience for the assigned tasks.

Technical: Monitoring, auditing and ongoing performance reviews on the quality of workmanship. Knowledge and access to technical support and third party inspection of workmanship, if disputed.

FPDC Membership is so much more than just a badge. All contractor members, regardless of size, are required to meet stringent membership criteria that ensure they have in place robust operating systems and policies that demonstrate professionalism.
